Title: The Bachelor of Pharmacy Practice (Bridge course) Regulations 2014

Duration of the course: 2 academic Years

The duration of the course shall be of two academic years with each year spread over a period of not less than 180 working days

Minimum qualification for admission to the course:

- Pass in Diploma in Pharmacy Course from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India approved under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act 1948.
- A valid registered Pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act 1948.
- A Minimum of four years of pharmacy practice experience in a community or hospital pharmacy.
 - A certificate from competent authority stating that the candidate is endorsed as Registered Pharmacist in the Drug License of a Pharmacy as proof practice experience in case of community pharmacist.
 - A certificate from the Principal/medical Superintendent/ competent person of the Hospital/ Health Unit stating that the candidate is working as a pharmacist will be accepted as proof of practice experience in case of hospital pharmacist.
- A "no objection certificate" from the employer in prescribed format.
